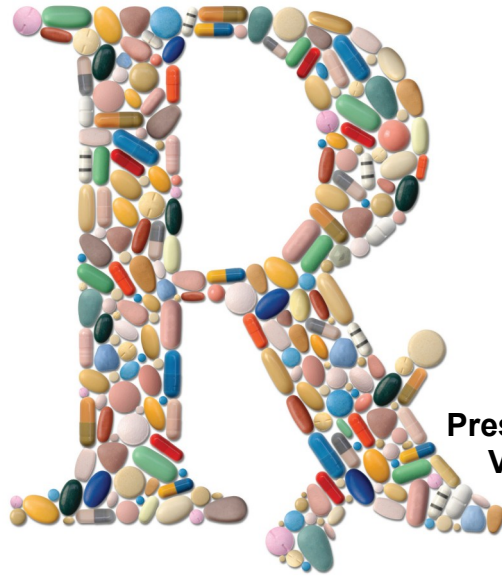

## Pharmaceutical Drop-Off Program



### This Includes:

- Prescription medicines
- expired and unused prescriptions and over-the-counter drugs
- over-the-counter and prescription medications as well as vitamins and supplements
- Controlled substances

Narcotics (OxyContin, Vicodin, etc.) Accepted ONLY at law enforcement sites

Prescribed medications

Over-the-counter medications

Medication samples

Medications for pets

Medicated ointments/lotions (prescription & over-the-counter)

Vitamins

Inhalers

EpiPens (unopened)

Residents are asked to black out any personal information (not the medication name or dosage) on their prescription containers.

Participants with household medications ONLY.

Doctor offices, veterinary offices and pharmacies are not covered under this current program.

Please keep your medications in their original containers. You may cross off your name and PERSONAL information ONLY. Please DO NOT cover up or remove the name or the dosage of the medication. All medications and their containers will be incinerated under law enforcement supervision.

### You CAN Bring:

Prescription and over-the-counter medications, ointments, sprays, inhalers, creams, vials and pet medications.
