NEW JOINT SEWER BOARD MEMBER

Chris Perry – Gloversville Director of Public Works was appointed to the Joint Sewer Board by the City of Gloversville at their May 26, 2020 City Council meeting.

READ ALOUD

Chairman Rizzo read aloud the following statement:

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, this hearing shall be held via teleconference. This meeting shall be open to the public by means of call-in connection information published in The Leader-Herald newspaper on May 19, 2020. This meeting shall be recorded and later transcribed.

PUBLIC HEARING – SEWER RATES

Chairman Rizzo opened a public hearing at 6:04 P.M. on proposed 2020-2021 sewer rates. Fiscal Officer Renda reviewed the proposed rate schedule, noting an approximate 2% increase in rates based on usage. Chairman Rizzo inquired if anyone from the public was present and invited them to speak. No one responded or voiced comments.

MOTION to RESCIND

On a motion made by Mr. Vose, seconded by Ms. Trudel, carried five (5) in favor, one (1) absent, and none (0) opposed, the Board authorized to rescind a motion previously approved on April 29, 2020 for adoption of the 2020-2021 sewer rates.

Adopt 2020-2021 Sewer Rates

On a motion made by Ms. Trudel, seconded by Mr. Siarkowski, carried five (5) in favor, one (1) absent, and none (0) opposed, the Board adopted the 2020-2021 sewer rates, effective May 1, 2020 as follows:
